MEETING SPACES

- Complimentary meeting space for all functions:
 - General Session Ballroom: ~20,000 sq. ft.
 (crescent rounds for 450, stage, AV, marketplace)
 - Breakout Session Rooms (5): ~1,000 sq. ft. (theater or classroom seating for 80-125)
 - Meals (Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner): ~8,000 sq. ft. (banquet rounds for 450)
 - Meeting Planner Office: ~1,000 sq. ft. (near meeting rooms)



HOTEL ACCOMMODATIONS

- Estimated room block commitment:
 - Setup Day: 80 rooms
 - Day One: 280 rooms
 - Day Two: 280 rooms
 - Day Three: 200 rooms
- Competitive room rates for current year bid*
- Room block is IATA commissionable
- One complimentary room for every 40 occupied
- One suite + ten room upgrades at group rate
- 15 staff rooms at a significantly reduced rate
- Five complimentary room nights for pre-event planning
- Group rate honored three days pre/post conference
- Three-week cutoff date for group reservations
- Resort fees waived where possible

VENUE REQUESTS



FOOD & BEVERAGE

- F&B minimum no higher than \$175,000
- Hotel to host/underwrite one conference breakfast in exchange for sponsor recognition
- Corkage fee waived throughout conference
- Ability to bring in water, beer, and pre-packaged snacks
- Ranges for high-quality meals:
 - Buffet Breakfast (with protein): \$35-\$45
 - Plated Breakfast (with protein): \$35-\$45
 - Plated Lunch: \$55-\$60
 - Plated Dinner: \$90-\$105



AUDIO VISUAL

- Ability to bring in outside AV companies and other vendors (décor, tradeshow, etc.) without incremental hotel fees
- Complimentary Wi-Fi for attendees in all meeting spaces



OTHER CONCESSIONS

- 12 complimentary parking passes for staff and speakers
- Two-night stay donated to the Summit Auction
- Security included in event contract (if required)
- Fees waived for banner hanging and placement of own product
